TO PREPARE FOR ALI'S CLASS, PLEASE GATHER THE FOLLOWING

12" x 12" We R Memory Keepers album

I am using this [We R Memory Keepers Classic Leather Vanilla album](#). You will need the 12" x 12" page protectors that come along with the album too.

white cardstock

I used both [12" x 12" cardstock](#) and [8 1/2" x 11" cardstock](#) for my hybrid album. I used sixteen sheets of 12" x 12" white cardstock as the background (each one holds two days). I used more 8 1/2" x 11" cardstock for printing all the header, footer, and journaling block elements.

patterned paper

You'll need at least one [6" x 12" piece of patterned paper](#) for the intro to your album. You may choose to add more to your album as strips between the journaling and photo.

fun stuff

[Embellishments](#) that will fit in a 6" wide x 1/2" tall space. Think [ribbon](#), [washi tape](#), [patterned paper](#), etc. Also remember that you can make this album any way that you want it to be - you may choose to just add the words and photos to new layouts in another album.

2" circle punch

I used a 2" circle punch for my title page.

journal or notebook for jotting down story ideas

My hope is that this project will encourage you in the habit of telling stories from your own life. As I went about the process of creating this album, ideas for how I wanted to respond to the writing prompt popped up throughout the day (as well as ideas for completely different stories - sometimes it feels like turning on a faucet). Having somewhere to store those ideas became an important part of the process. If you sit at a desk like I do for at least part of the day, a simple Word document might make sense as well.

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES

Photoshop or Photoshop Elements (optional)

If you want to create this album digitally, you'll need Photoshop Elements or Photoshop. You can find a free 30-day trial [here](#).

printer (optional)

If you want to create this album using the printable elements, you will need a printer.

Photoshop or Word (optional)

If you want to take advantage of the journaling templates you will need either Photoshop or Word.
